The Masters Degree in Organizational Leadership is designed using the principles of ADULT LEARNING. It assumes that each student possesses a mature measure of capacity for self-directed learning (e.g. the time, self-discipline, ability to read, research, reflect, synthesize and apply information). The classroom component of the learning process is organized on a “modular” basis (intensive, week-long sessions, 2 times each year). To benefit from this approach to learning, students must be able to organize their own learning programmes prior to and following after the classroom experience. Effective self-directed learning demands a significant level of personal discipline and skill in time management.

N.E.G.S.T. STATEMENT OF FAITH

We believe in: -

- (i) THE HOLY SCRIPTURES of the Old and the New Testament (a total of 66 Books) are the Word of God. It is divinely inspired, infallible, inerrant, entirely trustworthy and serves as a supreme authority in all matters of faith and conduct (2 Tim.3:16-17).
